

How to find the correct model of your Jensen product

All Jensen products are marked with the model name, for instance "Jensen Air:Link WBR 7954". The placement of the marking varies but in most cases you can find the model name on the backside or under the product.

Some products have different models and require different software/driver or firmware. To ensure that you use the correct software/driver/firmware versions, we have make a list of how to identify your product where multiple models exist. If your product is not listed below, it exist only one model of this product.

Jensen 56K Internet Modem

Jensen 56K Internet Modem exist in two different models (v1 and v2). The shape of the model will show if you have the old model "v1" or the new model "v2". See pictures below :

Jensen 56K PCI Internet Modem

Jensen 56K PCI Internet Modem exist in three different models (v1, v2 and v3). A sticker on the PCI modem can clarify which model you have. See the pictures below the right to verify which model you have.

Jensen 56K USB Internet Modem

Jensen 56K USB Internet Modem exist in two different models (v1 and v2). The old model "v1" had headphone output on the side of the modem while the new model does not have this. See the pictures below to verify which model you have.

Jensen Broadband Router II

Jensen Broadband Router II exist in two different models (v1 and v2). The new “v2” model has a red circle with the name “SE” inside on the bottom of the router, while the old “v1” model does not have this marking on the bottom of the router.



Jensen Air:Link 6554

Jensen Air:Link 6554 exist in three different models (v1, v2 and v3). The label on the backside of the adapter will show the name 6554, 6554v2 or 6554v3 depending on which model your adapter is.



Jensen Air:Link 7554

Jensen Air:Link 7554 exist in two different models (v1 and v2). The label on the backside of the USB adapter will show “Model No : AL7554” or “AL7554v2” depending on which model you have.



Jensen Air:Link WBR 7954

Jensen Air:Link WBR 7954 exist in two different models (v1 and v2). The label on the backside of the router will show “Model No : AL7954” or “Model No : AL7954v2” depending on which model you have.



Jensen USB Fast Ethernet Adapter

Jensen USB Fast Ethernet Adapter exist in two different models (v1 and v2). The old “v1” model use a dongle between the network cable and the adapter, while the new “v2” model can connect the network cable directly into the adapter.

Jensen Wireless Access Point

Jensen Wireless Access Point exist in two different models (v1 and v2). The label on the backside of the Access Point will have a FCC ID that show the difference. The old model (v1) will have an FCC ID that start with NKRWLAN, while the new model (v2) start with NKRAP.



Jensen Wireless Access Point - Bridge

Jensen Wireless Access Point Bridge exist in two different models (v1 and v2)

The V1 have two antenna connectors and three LED's in front.

The V2 have one antenna connector and four LED's in front.
